It is time once again to pass along the Guppies' coach title. Guppies is the LITW swim team for children, ages 2-7, who are not yet ready for the big swim team. Practices are held at the LITW pool 2 to 3 times a week for 15 minutes. Practice consists of the children getting into the water and "swimming" (no particular stroke is required) any way possible (children can use floatation devices) to a "catcher" (either a mom/dad or a big swim team member.) Practices are not mandatory and we try to have practices right before open swim. We also have meets just like the big swim team where everyone is a winner. Meets are held just prior to 4 or 5 of the big swim team home meets. Guppies begin in June and end mid-July.

Summer is just around the corner! This is my first year heading up our swim team. On behalf of the team, I want to extend a huge thank you to Nellie Masturzo who did a wonderful job as our coordinator for the past three years. I also want to thank her personally as she has been a big help to me as I take on this role. We are so happy that Kristen McKnight and Molly Wiberg will return as our coaches this summer. Swim Team is a great opportunity to have good clean fun with neighbors, young and old!

On Thursday, May 30 at 8:00 P.M., there will be a mandatory Parent and Team Meeting at the Pavilion. Please have at least one parent from each family attend. Bring your calendars to sign up to help with concessions, ribbons and scoring, and timing and line judging. There are more than 60 volunteer chances!

Please complete the registration form for our neighborhood swim team and send it back to me, or drop it off at my house, by May 14th. I need to declare the team with the Chagrin Valley Rec League on May 15th with an accurate count of swimmers. Participation costs remain the same - \$50 per swimmer; \$20 for 15-18 year-olds whose employment prevents them from attending practice on a regular basis and participating in less than half the meets; \$15 for swimmers practicing with another team, but willing to grace us with their presence at meets only.

***AGAIN this year there will be a LATE FEE of \$10 per family if your registration is not received by May 14th.

If you are unsure of whether your son/daughter is ready, sign him or her up. If the coaches feel he/she is not ready, we will refund your money.

The meet schedule will be published in the June Lakelines. Swimmers have the opportunity to purchase Lake in the Woods swimsuits at group rates at Chagrin Falls Step-In
