Lake in the Woods Community,

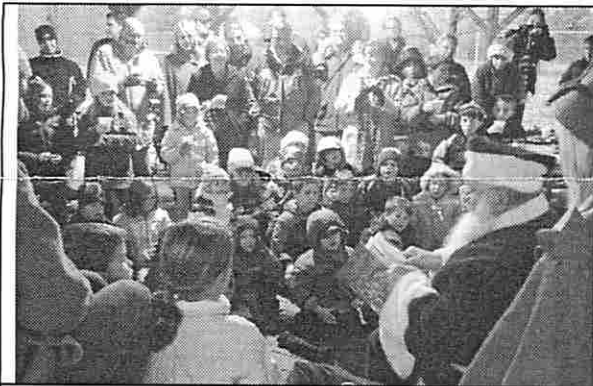

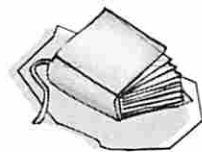
LAKE IN THE WOODS GOES GREEN
