Dear LITW Residents:

We hope everyone had a great July – summer sure is going fast! We still have a lot of great community activities scheduled for the rest of the summer and into the fall. Please check our website for details.

The trustees had their seventh meeting of the year on July 9th. The following are some quick notes from the meeting.

Finance-

As of June 9th we have about \$58,000 in the Sinking Fund, \$2,200 in the Lake Fund and about \$48,000 in our General Fund.

Aquatic Maintenance:

We have looked into purchasing more Amur fish for the lake. With guidance from Willow Valley and several other sources we are going to add more Amur fish soon to the lake to help with the algae and the overall health of the lake.

Social-

There was a great turnout for the Tie Dye T-Shirt event to get ready for the fourth of July. Thank you Laurie Lamb for organizing this event!

Women's Night Out sounds like it was a lot of fun for those who were able to attend. Thank you Beth Fleming for organizing this event!

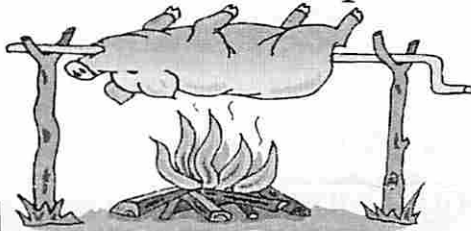
