


Get your bikes decorated and ready to ride for the annual LITW Bike Parade!

# 21st Annual Bainbridge Invitational

The tradition continues! The 21st Annual Bainbridge Invitational (BI) will be held at the Lake in the Woods Pool on Saturday, July 24th. If you are new to the neighborhood, the Lake in the Woods Swim Team hosts this community event each year. Between 200 - 250 swimmers and their families will attend this event. If you have never experienced a BI, I strongly suggest you walk or ride your bike up to the park and witness the excitement for yourself.

The BI is a community event where swimmers ages 8 to 18 compete in butterfly, backstroke, breaststroke, freestyle and relay events. Participating teams include Lake in the Woods, Chagrin Valley Athletic Club, Lake Lucerne, Bainbrook/Laurel Springs, and Wembley Club. The event begins at 9:00am and concludes around 3:00pm.

All participants receive a commemorative tee shirt... one of the many highlights of this event. To help us offset the costs of providing these "free" tee shirts to each swimmer, sponsorships are needed.
