
### **EASTER EGG HUNT**

## ARCHITECTURAL REVIEW COMMITTEE FRIEDNLY REMINDER

As the weather gets warmer, many of us will be looking to start home improvement projects. The exterior appearance of our homes is integral to the beauty and value of our neighborhood. Improvements and repairs are always welcome, but they should be done in a manner consistent with LITW guidelines and restrictions in order to maintain this beauty and value. To ensure that guidelines and restrictions are met, we ask that you continue to seek approval for all exterior house projects before they commence.

It is simple to get approval. We ask for a phone call or written request as well as written approval from any neighbors who will be affected by the exterior change. Drawings or plans also need to be submitted where they apply. All work, even a roof being replaced with the same color of roofing material, needs approval prior to the start date. Please keep the committee informed before starting your next exterior project.
