Dear LITW Residents:

The trustees had their tenth meeting of the year on October 8th. The following are some quick notes from the meeting.

Finance-

As of September 30th we have about \$59,000 in the Sinking Fund, \$3,300 in the Lake Fund and about \$24,000 in our General Fund.

Through September 30th we are at about 77% of our budget. We should be at or under budget for the year.

We still have 4 households that have not paid their dues yet. Liens have been placed on their property and interest is accruing. If you have not paid your dues, please contact Rich Dobre to make arrangements to get current.

Aquatic Maintenance-
